



Welcome Grades 1-5 to August in Action!

We are looking forward to working with your child in the August in Action Program! Our faculty is excellent and these next two weeks (July 31- August 11) are full of experiences that are irresistibly fun and exciting! Danielle Gerken and Caroline Adams will be the lead teachers, while Denyse Woods, Ashley McKee, and Teresa Duong will be the assistants for the Grades 1 & 2. Howard DeVennish will be the lead teacher and Ann Kelley and Whitnie Goins will be the assistant for the 3rd through 5th grade class.

All classes will be exploring the following themes:

Week One: Planes, Trains, and Automobiles

Week Two: It's a Mystery!

The children will swim in the Bexley pool each day (they will swim at CSG if it is raining). Please send your child's swim suit and a towel to camp and mark it with their name. We will have a basket to keep it in for the week.

Grades 1-5 will be going on all of the field trips together.

In this informational packet, you will find daily itineraries for each week which will detail the weeks activities, fieldtrips, and notices regarding special items to bring, appropriate clothing to wear for certain trips, etc.

Things to remember:

The August in Action Program runs Monday through Friday from 8:30am until 4:00pm. If your child needs to come earlier or stay later than these hours, you must sign them up for extended care. Extended care runs from 7:30 to 8:30am and from 4:00 to 6:00pm. It is held in the Lower School Multipurpose Room 113/Tech Lab. Meghan Kroll is the Early Hours and After Hours Coordinator. **IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE PARTICIPATING IN THE EXTENDED CARE PROGRAMS, HE/SHE SHOULD GO DIRECTLY TO HIS/HER CLASSROOM IN THE MORNING. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TEACHERS WILL BE IN THE CLASSROOM PREPARING FOR THE DAY, WHICH BEGINS AT 8:30AM.**

If your child is not signed up for the Extended Care Program, please be sure to look at the class lists that are posted outside the Multipurpose Room in order to know which classroom your child should go to first thing in the morning.

There will be dry erase boards outside each classroom indicating the day's agenda. If you are late arriving, you and/or your child will want to check the board to know where his/her group is at that time. Classrooms are most easily found if you enter CSG through the Lower School Entrance (on the corner of Broad and Drexel) and head right down the hallway.

LUNCH IS NOT PROVIDED (Except Friday, August 11 when we will be having a pizza party at Chuck E. Cheese). Your child will need to bring a packed lunch with a drink every day. We will provide snacks and drinks two times a day. If your child chooses, he/she may also want to bring a water bottle.

If your child has medication, it is important and expected that it be given to me (or your child's lead teacher to be passed onto me) with a written note giving instructions and permission for administration of the medication.

If you have a check, registration form, emergency medical form, etc. that still needs to be turned in upon the first day of the August Program, you will need to give them to me.

For safety reasons, your child will not be permitted to participate in fieldtrips or activities if his/her medical forms have not been completed and turned in.
